

# March 20 to April 1, 2002

# Introduction

As it proved much cheaper to extend our planned Easter in Egypt to 11 days from the original cramped 7 days by charter we did so thus paying 2700 Dk.kr (£ 230) from Billund, Denmark via Frankfurt to Cairo (Lufthansa). However, it was not as easy to bargain when it came to renting a car in the airport: 5200 Dk.kr (£430) was the price for 11 days with free mileage and insurance. The Corolla drove 2900 km without complaining, though. Apart from that it was a cheap journey. We spent 200 Dk.kr (£18) per person per day on traditional bread and water during the day and a good hearty local meal after sunset every day, gasoline (2 Dk.kr / litre (18p/litre)) and hotels.

Our itinerary was the following: Along the west coast of the Red Sea from Suez 700 km down to a bit south of Marsa Alam, back to take the ferry from Hurghada to Sharm el-Sheikh (on the Sinai Peninsula) (an idea that turned out quite expensive, i.e. 2000 Dk.kr (£180)). From The southern tip of Sinai we went up the east coast via St Catherine to the west coast to end in Suez. From here we went north to Port Said and toured the Nile Delta around Ishmailia – Abbasa - Bilbais and Az-Zaqaziq.

We had problems with the military along the Red Sea Coast with the climax being a (very polite) arrest and interrogation for six hours. After that experience we only chanced birding after having screened possible viewing from observation towers, which were placed at intervals of only three kms in certain areas. It is perceived suspicious to watch through scopes or even bins close to the Red Sea! In the Sharm el-Sheikh area the hotel resorts had taken nearly all of the coast and turned the rest into building sites, which meant that we wasted quite some time in that area. The reservation of Nabq was the only site really worth visiting. However, away from the coast Sinai proved very interesting indeed. The area around St Catherine is highly recommendable. The Delta

was extremely nice, abundant and vigorous and very friendly and not at all pushy inhabitants in the many villages. There were also here occasional police checks because we were still rather odd creatures, but it was much more relaxed birding in that area.

**Quail** *Coturnix coturnix* 1 on the lawn of a restaurant 8 km S Ain Sukhna.

Water Rail *Rallus aquaticus* 1 Wadi Ghuweiba.

Moorhen *Gallinula chloropus* 10 Faid. Seen regularly otherwise.

**Purple Gallinule** *Porphyrio porphyrio* **1** 3 km SW Abbassa.

Painted Snipe Rostratula benghalensis

11 in all: 1 female Al Qantara/ 1 male 40 km N Ismailia/ 1 male + 3 females in display + 1 45 km N Ismailia/ 2 females SW Abbassa/ 1 female E Abbassa/ 1 female 15 km E Abbassa.

**Oystercatcher** *Haemotopus ostralegus* **6** Nabq.

Black-winged Stilt *Himantopus himantopus*33 Embankment W Port Said/ 4 Abbassa – Bilbais – Qanater.

Senegal Thick-knee *Burhinus senegalensis* 15 39.5 km W Ismailia/ 2 SW Abbassa/ 2 3 km SW Abbassa.

Little Ringed Plover *Charadrius dubius* 8 Wadi Ghuweiba/ 8 33 km N Ismailia/ 9 SW Abbassa. Some observations besides.

**Ringed Plover** *Charadrius hiaticula* **13** Embankment W Port Said/ **24** 45 km N Ismailia. Single observations as well.

**Kittlitz's Plover** *Charadrius pecuaris* **1** 33 km N Ismailia.

Kentish Plover *Charadrius alexandrinus* 19 Nabq/ 25 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said. Single observations throughout.

**Greater Sand Plover** *Charadrius leschenaultii* **4** Nabq.

**Grey Plover** *Pluvialis squatarola* **44** Nabq. A few observations besides.

### **Spur-winged Plover** *Hoplopterus spinosus*

65 + 36 Ismailia/ 56 33 km N Ismailia/ 64 + 63 SW Abbassa. Besides very common wherever possible.

#### Little Stint Calidris minuta

**148** 33 km N Ismailia/ **140** 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ **100** 45 km N Ismailia/ **340** SW Abbassa. Some observations besides.

### Temminck's Stint Calidris temminckii

3 Al-Qantara/ 6 33 km N Ismailia/ 6 SW Abbassa. Besides single birds observed.

### Curlew Sandpiper Calidris ferruginea

**2** 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said.

### **Dunlin** Calidris alpina

185 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ 140 45 km N Ismailia. Some observations in smaller numbers, too.

### **Ruff** *Philomachus pugnax*

180 33 km N Ismailia/ 630 Embankment W Port Said/ 200 E Abbassa . Besides a few other observations.

Common Snipe *Gallinago gallinago*12 SW Abbassa. Otherwise only few birds seen.

# **Whimbrel** *Numenius phaeopus* **1** Nabq.

**Curlew** *Numenius arquata* **6** Nabq – and a few singles at other localities.

#### Redshank Tringa tetanus

5 El-Quseir/ 20 Nabq/ 6 40 km Ismailia – Port Said. Nothing much besides that.

### Marsh Sandpiper Tringa stagnatilis

**16** 33 km N Ismailia/ **7** 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ **262** Embankment W Port Said. Apart from these a few other observations.

#### **Greenshank** *Tringa nebularia* **4** Nabq, otherwise few observations.

Green Sandpiper Tringa ochropus

Seen in very low numbers at various localities.

### Wood Sandpiper Tringa glareola

4 Wadi Ghuweiba/ 4 10 km S Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel/ 5 33 km N Ismailia. Besides single observations.

**Common Sandpiper** *Actitis hypoleucos* Single observations.

**Turnstone** *Arenaria interpres* **14** Nabq.

Sooty Gull Larus hemprichii 1 El-Quseir/ 14 Nabq.

White-eyed Gull *Larus leucophthalmus* 74 Ain Sukhna/ 40 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 63 32 km S Ain Sukhna/ 82 Sigala-Hurghada-Magawish/ 44 4 km N Hurghada. Besides seen very regularly at the Red Sea.

**Great Black-headed Gull** *Larus ichthyaetus* **1 2cy** 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna.

Black-headed Gull *Larus ridibundus* 100 Ain Sukhna/ 60 Embankment W Port Said. Besides these not very many observed.

Slender-billed Gull *Larus genei* 500 Ain Sukhna/ 650 Embankment W Port Said. Besides small assemblies noted.

Lesser Black-backed Gull *Larus fuscus* 100 Ain Sukhna. A few more observations only.

Herring Gull *Larus argentatus*60 Ain Sukhna. Besides not seen that often.

**Gull-billed Tern** *Gelochelidon nilotica* 1 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ 4 Port Said – 10 km W/ 4 Embankment W Port Said.

Caspian Tern Sterna caspia

**5** 4 km N Hurghada/ 7 El-Quseir/ 6 El-Quseir – Marsa Alam/ 4 Nabq/ 4 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said. Besides observed at several spots along the Red Sea.

Swift Tern *Sterna bergii* 1 Ain Sukhna/ 3 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 6 32 km S Ain Sukhna.

Lesser Crested Tern *Sterna bengalensis* 2 Ain Sukhna.

Sandwich Tern *Sterna sandvicensis*21 Ain Sukhna. Small gatherings observed also.

**Common Tern** *Sterna hirundo* **25** Ismailia/ **30** Port Said – 10 km W. Besides a few more observations. Little Tern *sterna albifrons* 1 Faid/ 1 SW Abbassa.

**Whiskered Tern** *Chlidonias hybridus* **200** Port Said – 10 km W/ **1700** Embankment W Port Said. Small groups noted as well.

**Crowned Sandgrouse** *Pterocles coronatus* **2** 68 km S Safaga.

**Spotted Sandgrouse** *Pterocles senegallus* **2** 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna.

Rock Dove *Colomba livia*130 Monastery of St Catherine. Apart from that commonly seen.

**Collared Dove** *Streptopelia decaocto* Noted with much regularity, never in high numbers, however.

Palm Dove *Streptopelia senegalensis*108 Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel – Faid/ 174 Faid. Seemed to be all over the place.

**Ring-necked Parakeet** *Psittacula krameri* **1** 7.5 km W Ismailia.

Senegal Coucal Centropus senegalensis2 E Abbassa/ 1 SW Abbassa/ 1 E Abbassa, village S of canal/ 1 3 km SW Abbassa.

**Barn Owl** *Tyto alba* **2** Port Tawfig.

**Eagle Owl** *Bubo bubo ascalaphus* 1 39 km N Hurghada.

**Short-eared Owl** *Asio flammeus* **1** 15 km E Abbassa.

Swift *Apus apus* 1 N 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna.

Pallid Swift *Apus pallidus* Single observations. **10 N** Wadi Madsus/ **56** Faid. A few more observations only.

Alpine Swift *Apus melba* 1 N Wadi Ghuweiba/ 2 N Wadi Madsus.

Kingfisher *Alcedo atthis*2 Faid, and a few more observations in the Delta.

### Pied Kingfisher Ceryle rudis

**33** Faid/ **18** 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ **25** Embankment W Port Said/ **35** + **30** SW Abbassa. It was very common in the Delta especially.

### White-breasted Kingfisher Halcyon smyrnensis

37 Faid. Besides seen a lot in the Delta, but in the Delta only.

### Little Green Bee-eater Merops orientalis

1 Faid/ 7 E Abbassa/ 3 E Abbassa/ 1 15 km E Abbassa/ 1 Abbassa - Bilbais - Qanater / 2 Qanater.

### Green Bee-eater Merops persicus

15 10 km S Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel/ 57 Faid/ 22 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ 47 7.5–39.5 km W Ismailia/ 23 39.5 km W Ismailia/ 23 + 50 SW Abbassa/ 26 15 km E Abbassa. Otherwise many observations in the Delta.

### Hoopoe Upupa epops

5 Ain Sukhna/ 1 N + 2 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 5 Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel – Faid/ 6 Faid/ 4 Ismailia. Besides many observations of single individuals.

Wryneck *Jynx torquilla* 1 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 1 Faid.

Desert Lark Ammomanes deserti

**5** Monastery of St Catherine.

### Short-toed Lark Calandrella brachydactyla

**350** 37.5-58.7 km S Suez/ **265** N Ain Sukhna-29.3 km S/ **750** N 29.3. km S Ain Sukhna/ **290** Magawish-Safaga. Abundant migration along the western Red Sea coast from Suez to Hurghada.

Crested Lark *Galerida cristata* 9 40 km N Ismailia – Port Said/ 10 SW Abbassa. Otherwise observed widely in the north in small numbers.

**Sand Martin** *Riparia riparia* **80** 10 km S Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel/ **100** Embankment W Port Said. Observed in small numbers

### African Rock Martin Ptyonoprogne fuligula

**5** 23 km S Suez/ **3 pairs nesting** at an oasis 2 km S Ain Sukhna/ **9** Village of St Catherine/ **10** oasis 20 km NW St Catherine. Singles also noted.

Crag Martin Ptyonoprogne rupestris

1 El Quseir – Marsa Alam.

Barn Swallow *Hirundo rustica*70 10 km S Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel/ 80 Faid / 200 Al Qantara. Counted in small numbers otherwise.

### **Red-rumped Swallow** *Hirundo daurica*

19 N + 13 Wadi Ghuweiba/ 30 Ain Sukhna/ 49 Faid. Many single birds noted throughout.

# House Martin Delichon urbica

**20** Faid – apart from that few observations.

**Tawny Pipit** *Anthus campestris* Scattered observations at the Red Sea and in the Delta.

**Tree Pipit** *Anthus trivialis* **1** Ain Sukhna, **1** N 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna.

**Meadow Pipit** *Anthus pratensis* **2** 40 km N Ismailia.

**Red-throated Pipit** *Anthus cervinus* **15** Sharm el-Sheik/ **11** E Abbassa . Otherwise a few singles.

Water Pipit *Anthus spinoletta* 1 Al-Qantara/ 4 40 km N Ismailia.

Yellow Wagtail *Motacilla flava* 50 Magawish, and numerous presence at the Red Sea and in the Delta, many of the race *feldegg* 

White Wagtail *Motacilla alba*220 10 km S Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel. Observed throughout the trip.

Yellow-vented Bulbul *Pycnonotus xanthopygos*54 Faid. Very regular in the Delta, observed in small numbers in the south.

Nightingale *Luscinia megarhynchos* 1 14.5 km S El-Quseir/ 1 39.5 km S El-Quseir.

Bluethroat *Luscinia svecica* 1 Ain Sukhna/ 1 39.5 km S El-Quseir/ 1 33 km N Ismailia.

Redstart *Phoenicurus phoenicurus*3 Ain Sukhna/ 1 Village of St Catherine.

**Blackstart** *Cercomela melanura* **A pair** seen at 22 km on the road deviating westwards from the Nuweiba-Dahab road.

**Isabelline Wheatear** *Oenanthe isabellina* **4** Nabq. Otherwise observed regularly, mostly alone.

Wheatear *Oenanthe oenanthe* 10 N + 6 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna. Scattered observations, mostly at the Red Sea.

Black-eared Wheatear Oenanthe hispanica

1 Wadi Ghuweiba-Ain Sukhna/ 1 75 km N Ras Gharid/ 1 Village of St Catherine/ 1 40 km N Ismailia.

### Desert Wheatear Oenanthe deserti

1 N 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 1 Magawish-Safaga/ 2 El-Quseir – Marsa Alam.

**Finch's Wheatear** *Oenanthe finchii* **1** 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna.

Mourning Wheatear *Oenanthe lugens* 2 N St Catherine/ 1 Village of St Catherine.

### White-crowned Black Wheatear Oenanthe leucopyga

**3** Wadi Ghuweiba-Ain Sukhna/ **3** Monastery of St Catherine/ **3** Village of St Catherine/ **7** oasis 20 km NW St Catherine. Observed with regularity in deserted places.

Blue Rock Thrush Monticola solitarius1 Wadi Ghuweiba/ 4 Ain Sukhna/ 1 Ain Sukhna-29.3 km S.

Blackbird *Turdus merula*4 Faid. Single observations in the Delta.

Fan-tailed Warbler *Cisticola juncidis*31 Faid. Commonly observed in the Delta.

**Graceful Warbler** *Prinia gracilis* **7** Faid/ **10** SW Abbassa. Commonly noted in the Delta.

Scrub Warbler Scotocerca inquieta3 N St Catherine area/ 5 Monastery of St Catherine.

Savi's Warbler *Locustella luscinioides* 3 Ismailia – 7.5 km W.

**Sedge Warbler** *Acrocephalus shoenobaenus* **8** at a restaurant 8 km S Ain Sukhna. A few more observations.

**Reed Warbler** *Acrocephalus scirpaceus* Noted occasionally.

Clamorous Reed Warbler Acrocephalus stentoreus 6 Faid/ 5 7.5 km W Ismailia/ 5 39.5 km W Ismailia. Very regular in the Delta

**Great Reed Warbler** *Acrocephalus arundinaceus* **1** El-Quseir – Marsa Alam.

**Olivaceous Warbler** *Hippolais pallida* 1 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 1 14.5 km S El-Quseir.

**Spectacled Warbler** *Sylvia conspicillata* **1** oasis 2 km S Ain Sukhna.

## Sardinian Warbler Sylvia melanocephala

1 Wadi Ghuweiba-Ain Sukhna/ 1 96 km S Safaga.

### **Rüppel's Warbler** *Sylvia rueppelli*

1 10 km after westward turn-off from Nuweiba – Dahab road/ 2 village of St Catherine/ 8 oasis 20 km NW St Catherine/ 1 33 km N Ismailia.

## Lesser Whitethroat Sylvia curruca

Widespread observations.

Eastern Bonelli's Warbler *Phylloscopus orientalis*2 oasis 58.7 km S Suez/ 1 N St Catherine/ 1 Monastery of St Catherine/ 2 Village of St Catherine

## Chiffchaff Phylloscopus collybita

15 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna. Observed regularly.

# Great Grey Shrike Lanius excubitor

1 (aucheri) 39.5 km S El-Quseir/ 1 39.5 km W Ismailia/ 1 E Abbassa.

## Woodchat Shrike Lanius senator

1 Wadi Ghuweiba/ 2 Ain Sukhna/ 2 29.3 km S Ain Sukhna/ 3 El-Quseir – Marsa Alam/ 1 N St Catherine area/ 1 Village of St Catherine.

## Masked Shrike Lanius nubicus

2 Ain Sukhna/ 1 39.5 km S El-Quseir/ 1 N St Catherine area.

# House Crow Corvus splendens

Very common in the area around Suez: **300** Port Tawfig, **2000 S** Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel, but also **39** as far south as Ras Gharid.

**Hooded Crow** *Corvus cornix* Seen a lot, but not in big numbers.

# Brown-necked Raven Corvus ruficollis

17 37.5-58.7 km S Suez/ 12 75 km N Ras Gharid/ 25 Safaga-68 km S/ 33 El-Quseir – Marsa Alam/ 18 39.5 km S El-Quseir. Many singles noted along the Red Sea.

### Tristam's Grackle Onychognathus tristramii

3 Village of St Catherine/ 2 oasis 20 km NW St Catherine.

House Sparrow *Passer domesticus* 500 S Ahmad Hamdi Tunnel/ 380 Faid. Very common.

**Streaked Weaver** *Ploceus manyar* **9** E Abbassa (a male building a nest).

**Goldfinch** *Carduelis carduelis* A couple of observations in the Delta.

Sinai Rosefinch *Carpodacus synoicus* 6 Monastery of St Catherine.

**Corn Bunting** *Miliaria calandra* **55** 15 km E Abbassa.
