China, Vietnam, Cambodia and Thailand 3/9-2004 – 11/2-2005.

I flew to Beijing 3/9. In China I spent two month. One and a half travelling in Sichuan-province around on the Tibetan-plateau. Then I travelled down through Vietnam in three weeks, not much birding there. I went up to Cambodia on the Mekong River. Spent some days in Phnom Penh and looked out Angkor Wat and a visit up to the wetland "Ang Tropeang Thmor Sarus Crane Reserv". Back to Phnom Penh and by bicycle down in south Cambodia and by the cost up to Thailand and Bangkok. Ok I didn't bicycle all the way. Cheated two times and went by bus. But it was a lot of bicycle. In Thailand I birded quite a lot in the north, southeast and central parts.

China 3/9-1/11

Beijing. Must look at building and things. But there are some nice parks around in the city where birds can be found. By the summer palace I found some birds. Also made a day-trip to the great wall a place called **Simatai**. Then I took the train to **Chengdu**. Went by train from Chengdu to Emei-town. Spent four days at **Emei Shan**. It is a mountain well visited of Buddhist monks. It is good tracks and stairs al up to the top. Food and accommodation are available in several places on the way up so it is easy to spend some days here. After this I made a trip around in **Sichuan** by local busses. Chengdu-Songpan (a 5 days horse-trekk in the mountain around here)-Maerkung-Ganzi-Litang (good trekking possibilities around the town)-Zhongdian (1 day visit to **Napa Lake**)-Lijiang. Between Zhongdian and Lijang I also made the **Tiger Leaping Gore**, a very beautiful trekking gore (T.L.G. in the bird-list).

To go around here with local buses is not comfortable but no problem, a advice is to bye a map over the area with the cities in Chinese since. Other vice it can be difficult to find the right bus and to get bus tickets. From Lijang I took bus and train to Guangzhou in SE. I visit a friend here and did not see so many birds. From Guangzhou by buses and train down to Hanoi in Vietnam.

Vietnam 1/11-28/11

Went by tourist-buses from Hanoi to Ho Chi Minh City. The easiest and cheapest way to travel in Vietnam for foreigners.

Not much bird watching here but I stayed at some sites. I made a day-trip with a rent motorbike to **Bach Ma N.P.** It was nice forest area. Here you can easy stay two days and sleep at the top. **Hoian** a pleasant village. From the village down to the sea there is a about 4 km. Along this road you find rice-fields areas and wetland. This place I find really good for Kingfishers, Herons and Waders. The only place I visit in the highlands was **Dalat**. Here I made a one-day trip to Lingbian-mountain, this was nice as a one-day trip. But if I do that place again I would try to get to Cat Tien N.P. instead. From here I went on to Ho Chi Minh City and up to Cambodia on the Mekong-river.

Cambodia 28/11-27/12

Start in Phnom Penh went up to Siam Reap, Angkor Wat and a wetland in that area. Back to Phnom Penh and bicycle from Phnom Penh down south to Sianoukville and to Thailand.

First birds cite was **Ang Tropeang Thmor Sarus Crane Reserv** (short: A.T.T.) very good wetland. To come here I took a bus from Siam Reap to Thai border and jump of at Prey Mwan (a seine here with a Bengal Flurican) from here motor-taxi to the cite. I spend one afternoon and one morning here.

In Angkor Wat there is good bird watching to so it is worth a visit, not only for the impressing temples. I spend 1 morning at Basset marshes 15 km north of Phnom Penh. A wetland area that is easy to bicycle to from Phnom Penh. Go National Road 5 to Prek Phneuw village, after a bridge turn left by a big sign with a Michelin man. Here you go throw a market just follow the road and you will find the wetlands and it possible to go on and around the lake area, it's not to far.

Ream N.P. from Ream beach you can follow the road up past the village and in to the forest. The road gets smaller and smaller and is very good to walk. I was only here one morning, stay here more days. I went via Sianoukville and Khrong Koh Khong up in to Thailand.

Thailand 27/12-2004 - 10/2-2005

The trip in Thailand started with bicycling up to Bangkok along the cost from Cambodia. Along this way I birdwatched one morning in **Khao Khitchakut N.P**. Didn't see much here.

Next birding place was Khok Kham (KK) south of Bangkok. Lots of waders and good bird watching.

After this I went up to Chiang Mai to visit some national parks around there. I spent 6 days at **Doi Inthanon** (D.I.), one day at **Doi Chang Dao** (D.C.D.), three at **Doi Ang Khang** (D.A.K.). In this area I rent a car together with a birdwatcher from Alaska, it was comfortable to go around there with a car, except the left-hand driving. Went back to Bangkok and down to Koh Chang. Here I relaxed for a week and didn't see many birds. I ended my journey with one week birding in **Khao Yai** N.P. (K.Y.). A cool place with good birding.
