# Trip Report Madeira 22 February – 1 March 2005

Together with my two children, Alexander 13 years and Nina 9 years I made a combined vacation and birding tour to Madeira. We flew from Malmö-Sturup airport to Funchal, Madeira with Solresor travel agency. The flight took 4:20 hours. We bought the trip on the Internet (on the very good site for finding low fare travels: solfaktor.com). We paid 891 € (8067 SKr) in total and that included a regular hotel (Estrelicia) double room and breakfast. We rented a Renault Clio through the Internet in advance on Avis. It cost us 195 €(1765 SKr) for a week including free mileage, insurance and self reduction.

The weather was quite rainy and windy for two days and with showers and sun the others. Temperatures were around 16 at the coast but once in the mountains even below zero with snow.

Travelling with two children and only my son with birding as an interest, made us not birding 100%, but were also doing some more typical tourist activities. In total 33 bird species were seen.

**Ruddy Turnstone** (Arenaria interpres)

1 Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1 Caniçal harbour 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2 Machico 25<sup>th</sup>, 20 Funchal harbour 25<sup>th</sup>, 20 Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup> and 2 Lido, Funchal 1<sup>st</sup>.

Mediterranean Gull (Larus melanocepalus)

1 first winter Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Black-headed Gull** (Larus ridibundus)

25 Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup>, 10 first winter Machico 25<sup>th</sup> and 20 Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup>

Mew Gull (Larus canus)

1 first winter Machico 25<sup>th</sup>.

Lesser Black-backed Gull (Larus fuscus) 15 ad Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup> and 5 ad Funchal harbour 25<sup>th</sup>. **Yellow-legged Gull** (Larus michahellis atlantis) 150 Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup>, 20 Caniçal harbour 23<sup>rd</sup>, 5 Porto Moniz 24<sup>th</sup>, 75 Funchal harbour 25<sup>th</sup>, 25 Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup>, 20 flying S Porto Moniz 28<sup>th</sup> and 55 Lido, Funchal 1<sup>st</sup>. **Sandwich Tern** (*Sterna sandvicensis*) 1 Funchal harbour 25<sup>th</sup> and possibly the same bird Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup>. **Roseate Tern** (Sterna dougallii) 1 ad Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>. **Common Tern** (Sterna hirundo) 1 ad flying W Lido, Funchal 1<sup>st</sup>. **Feral Pigeon** (Columba livia) 75 Garajau 22<sup>nd</sup>, 25 Ponta de São Lourenço 23<sup>rd</sup>, 15 Machico 25<sup>th</sup>, 50 Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup>, 15 Ponta do Pargo 28<sup>th</sup> and 5 Lido, Funchal 1<sup>st</sup>. Birds seen in almost every village and in the mountains. **Trocaz Pigeon** (Columba trocaz) 103 Ribeiro Frio 25<sup>th</sup>. **Eurasian Collared Dove** (Streptopelia decaocto) 1 outside Canical 23<sup>rd</sup>. **Plain Swift** (Apus unicolor) 25 Garajau 22<sup>nd</sup>. A few small groups were seen around Funchal on several occations. **Eurasian Skylark** (Alauda arvensis) 4 Ponta do Pargo 28<sup>th</sup>. Berthelot's Pipit (Anthus berthelotii madeirensis) 20 Ponta de São Lourenço 23<sup>rd</sup>. **Meadow Pipit** (Anthus pratensis) 2 Ponta de São Lourenço 23<sup>rd</sup>. **Grey Wagtail** (*Motacilla cinerea*) 5 Caniçal harbour 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2 Ribeiro Frio 25<sup>th</sup>, 2 Machico 25<sup>th</sup>, 3 Funchal harbour 25<sup>th</sup> and 1 Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup>. White Wagtail (Motacilla alba) 1 Ponta do Pargo 28<sup>th</sup>. **European Robin** (Erithacus rubecula) 10 singing Rabaçal, Levada Risco 24<sup>th</sup> and 2 Ribeiro Frio 25<sup>th</sup>. Several more birds seen and heard singing in the mountains and in Funchal. **Common Blackbird** (*Turdus merula cabrerae*) 1 Funchal harbour 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1 singing Lido and Funchal 1<sup>st</sup>. Common in many places. **Blackcap** (Sylvia atricapilla heineken) 1 warning Hotel Estrelicia, Funchal 22<sup>nd</sup> and 5 Machico 25<sup>th</sup>. Single birds seen or heard in most places. Madeira Firecrest (Regulus madeirensis) 15 Rabaçal, Levada Risco 24<sup>th</sup> and 10 Ribeiro Frio 25<sup>th</sup>. **Spanish Sparrow** (*Passer hispaniolensis*) 10 Caniçal harbour 23<sup>rd</sup> and more birds heard in the Caniçal village. **Common Chaffinch** (*Fringilla coelebs maderensis*) A few heard in the mountains. Atlantic Canary (Serinus canaria) 10 Hotel Estrelicia, Funchal 22<sup>nd</sup>, 5 Ponta de São Lourenço 23<sup>rd</sup>, 5 Machico 25<sup>th</sup>, 15 Funchal harbour 25<sup>th</sup>, 5 Funchal harbour 26<sup>th</sup>, 40 Ponta do Pargo 28<sup>th</sup> and 5 Lido, Funchal 1<sup>st</sup>. **European Goldfinch** (*Carduelis carduelis parva*)

5 Machico 25<sup>th</sup>. Also observed on several occasions in Funchal and other places. **Common Linnet** (*Carduelis cannabina nana*) 15 in flock with Canaries Ponta de São Lourenço 23<sup>rd</sup>.
