Trip report, southeast Bulgaria 17-24 May 2008

This report is a summary of a combined 1-week work and bird watching trip to Bulgaria. To allow sufficient time for work we minimized driving and allocated little time to localities traditionally visited by birders, viz. the wetland localities surrounding Burgas, in favor of a prolonged stay (4 nights) in Madjarovo in Eastern Rhodopes. We did not use a local bird guide or driver.

General aspects

Accommodation. We had made reservation for all nights before hand, which, in retrospect, proved unnecessary as late May is outside the peak tourist season. The only "problematic" stay was the in the BSPB Nature Information Center "Eastern Rhodopes" in Madjarovo marin.kurtev@bspb.org, which did not respond to subsequent e-mail inquiries and had to be contacted by telephone (+359 3720 345, +359 878 599 367) (good English spoken though). We were told that the first night was fully booked, but this proved wrong upon our arrival. The center was a perfect place to stay (3 bedrooms that can host 3-4 persons each), located in tranquil and very beautiful mountain surroundings, and cheap. There is also a restaurant in the house. Highly recommended. Beware though, the beds are hard!

Car rental. We rented car through Hertz at Burgas Airport. Carefully check the fuel meter at pick up and make sure to replace gas to exactly the same level when returning the car. This seems to be strictly reinforced.

Maps. It is difficult to get good maps of Bulgaria outside the country. Our 1:400 000 scale map from Freytag & Berndt was unreliable in details (e.g. missing roads). At the BSPB Center in Madjarovo we purchased a local tourist 1:100 000 scale map over Eastern Rhodopes which was very useful for that area.

Itenary with some highlights

17 May. Arrival Burgas Airport at lunch time. Picking up rental car, driving towards Krajmorie, short stop at Burgas Lake. Afternoon walk along Black Sea coast at Krajmorie, evening excursion along northern, western and southern side of Lake Mandras. Overnight stay at Krajmorie. Nice rural areas west and south of Lake Mandras with small roads sparsely trafficked. High densities of Black-headed Sparrows, Red-backed Shrikes and Bee-eaters. A large flock (c. 150) of White Storks roosting in oak trees.

18 May. Leaving Krajmorie, quick stops at Ropotamo River Reserve nearby Primorsko. Carevo, Kondolovo, Bosna, Varovnik, Boljarovo, Elhovo, Topolovgrad. Evening excursion primarily south of Topolovgrad in Sakar region. Overnight stay Hotel Sakar, Topolovgrad. Three singing Semi-collared Flycatchers at Ropotamo River stopping site (a bit frustrating not to be able to walk outside the parking lot here). Very nice contiguous oak forest extending from the Carevo towards Elhovo. Sparsely populated and few signs of recent forestry. Highlights here were a Middle Spotted Woodpecker and a good view of European Wild Cat slowly walking in front of the car. Masked Shrike encountered at an unplanned stop (details of this locality, see species list below). Booted Eagle souring over the road at Elhovo, two Lesser Spotted Eagles hunting over scenic pasture land east of Topolovgrad. Several Isabelline Wheatears in the same area.

19 May. Topolovgrad, Ljubimec, Malko Gradiste, Madzarovo. Overnight stay in Madjarovo. Evening excursion in the surroundings of Madjarovo (Topolovo village). A large colony of Bee-eaters south of Topolovgrad. Masked shrike (2 males), Olive-tree Warbler, 10 Black Storks and 2-3 Booted Eagles at Jerusalimovo gorge (details about the locality, see species list below). Beautiful views over the Arda River after Borislavci in the Eastern Rhodopes. Eight Griffon Vultures and one Long-legged Buzzard soaring over the cliffs at Kovan Kaja. Two Egyptian Vultures sitting on the ground close to road in Dolni Glavanak village.

20 May. Madjarovo. Afternoon excursion west of Madjarovo along the southern side of the Ardas River. Several Sombre Tits in the slopes north of the river in the morning, many Hoopoes calling in the valley. A flock of 25 Rosy-coloured Starlings. Eastern Bonelli's Warbler singing.

21 May. Madjarovo. Morning excursion in the surroundings of Madjarovo. Severeral Subalpine Warblers and Orphean Warbler (details, see below). Eight Rosy-coloured Starlings flying over the valley in high speed. Rock Sparrow (details below), Peregrine and European Wild cat at Kovan Kaja. A flock of Black Storks chased by dogs along the Arda River in the late evening.

- 22 May. Madjarovo. Morning excursion to Studen Kladenec och Dolna Kula. Black Kite at two places along the road. Black Stork breeding in a cliff, Levant Sparrowhawk and intimate sights of perching Roller in the very scenic Dolna Kula area. Golden Eagle and Egyptian Vulture in Studen Kladenec. Eastern Bonelli's Warbler singing at the BSPB Center, Scops Owl calling during the night.
- 23 May. Transport Madjarovo, Svilengrad, Topolovgrad, Elhovo, Sredec, Lake Burgas, Pomorio, Nesebar. Overnight stay in Nesebar. A pair of Western Rock Nuthatch in the pillars of Kovan Koja (details in the species list). Two Imperial Eagles in the Sakar mountains (N of Svilengrad).
- 24 May. Drive Nesebar to Burgas Airport, leaving Burgas in early afternoon.

Olive-tree Warbler *Hippolais olivetorum* we had two singing males just north of the road crossing at the southern end of the Jerusalimovo Gorge. This gorge, which is a protected area, is located immediately west of the Jerusalimovo village, c. 8km NW of Svilengrad (at the Bulgarian-Turkish-Greece border). We also had very good views of two males of Masked Shrikes here. Three Olive-tree Warblers were heard and seen at close distance in open shrub land 5 km east of Madjarovo, directly south of the Malko Brjagovo-Borislavci-Madjarovo road junction.

Subalpine Warbler *Sylvia cantillans* 6-7 singing birds north of the Arda River 1.5 km west of the Madjarovo along the road towards Gorni Glavanak village

Orphean Warbler *Sylvia hortensis* 1 pair, apparently making a breeding attempt at the Arda River bank at the opposite side from the BSPB Centre in Madjarovo. Three singing birds east of the Madjarovo at the Olive-tree Warbler site, see above.

Masked Shrike Lanius nubicus driving westwards from Sredec to Elhovo 18 May we stopped the car at a parking lot on the northern side of the road, 4 km east of the Goljamo Krusevo village, at a seemingly good spot for Masked Shrike (open canopied oak forest). We almost immediately encountered two males very close to the road. (We saw them again on the return trip 23 May). Two males were also seen at the Jerusalimovo Gorge (see Olive-tree Warbler text above).

Hermann's Tortoise *Testudo hermanni* – one observation in dry river beds of Arda in Madjarovo

European Glass Lizard *Ophisaurus apodus* – three individuals killed by cars and one living specimen outside Madjarovo

Nose-horned Viper *Vipera ammodytes* – encountered sun-bathing on the smaller road in the countryside

Common Tree Frog *Hyla arborea* – heard outside BSPB Center in Madjarovo
