Hotel Steigenberger, El Gouna, Egypt 6 March – 12 March 2009

My wife and I stayed at Steigenberger hotel during this period on a combined birding and vacation trip. Birding was done every day during the morning hours, 06:00 - 09:00 and during two days watching the raptor migration from the El Gouna entrance gate. Weather was sunny, 18 - 28 Celsius during the entire period. Winds were southeasterly 6 - 8 March and from Northwest or North 9 - 12 March.

Top of the week were 10 000 white storks during two days, which came in huge flocks of up to 2 500 birds, 90 black storks, 50 steppe eagles on the same day, nile valley sun birds and an adult male Cretzschmar's bunting.

The first morning I met two German birders, who were almost sure they had seen a Senegal thick-knee that same morning close to the water in the south-west corner of the golf course. Despite several visits in that area I didn't see it. Actually, I didn't see any "thick-knee" at all during the whole week.

As the Egyptian pound more or less follows the USD, it is now quite expensive staying at the luxury hotels in El Gouna. A dinner for two, one beer and one water included, cost 400 Egyptian pounds, which equals SEK 700 or USD 80.

Raptor migration: 10:00- 14:00 on 9 March, strong NW wind and 09:30 – 13:00 on 10 March, strong N wind)

I started off just outside the entrance gate on 9 March, where there is something like an oasis, where you can find some shelter under the palm trees and behind some smaller rocks. It didn't take long before the security guys wondered what I was doing there. They were, however, very friendly and very enthusiastic when I let them watch a swarm of storks through my spotting-scope. Unfortunately, this enthusiasm coincided with the steppe eagle peak when some 20 eagles passed under a few hectic minutes around 11:00. I cannot completely rule out that some other eagle passed during these minutes. After a while they invited me to stay with them at the gate and that was very helpful as some of these guys were really sharp-eyed and pointed out a lot of birds which I probably had missed otherwise. One of them was constantly watching the sky and, maybe, an Egyptian birder was born this day! Next time, I will bring them a guide to Egyptian birds.
