SHORT DIARY

2–3 Oct

Travel days for Carl-Axel, Gert and Göran, with start in Copenhagen. Via Bangkok we reached Melbourne at 8 p.m.

4 Oct

Full day birding in Melbourne area together with Guy Dutson. We visited **Point Addis, Anglesea Heathland** and **Werribee Water Treatment Plant**. A very bird rich day with 106 species. Roger and Sören S arrived to Melbourne at 9.40 p.m. The rest of the group was stucked in Hong Kong.

5 Oct

Bengt, Christer and Sören J arrived happily at 7. a.m. (the rest of the group were happy too ☺). Left Melbourne at 8.45 a.m. together with Phil and Patricia Maher. The forthcoming week we were in their hands. Phil was in response of the birding and Patricia catered us with marvelous lunches and dinners out in the field. Especially the cakes were a great memory! During the day we travelled slowly through west Victoria via Bendigo to **Ouyen**. We arrived at 7.25 p.m. We made many short and longer stop during the transport, e.g. **Lancefield, Heathcote** and **Inglewood**. Many new species were seen. Total 83 species for the day.

6 Oct

Full day birding in **Hattah-Kulkyne NP**. Lunch at Lake Hattah. We found some Mallefowl mound but no birds around. We ended up with 74 species.

7 Oct

Started in **Bronzewing Reserve**, 7–11 a.m. *Mallefowl*, Yes! Before lunch we had a shorter visit to **Murray Sunset NP** where we saw our first *Emu* and also found *Striated Grasswren*. Terrific picnic lunch in Ouyen where Patricia had waited a long time. In afternoon transport to Deniliquin (3.45–7.45 p.m.) with a longer stop at **Worrinen** (a wetland). 87 species today.

8 Oct

Breakfast at 6.30 and left for **Gulpa Island State Forest** at 7 a.m. We birded here to 12.30 p.m. Nice eucalyptus forest with quite a few new species, e.g. *Sitellas*. Back to Deniliquin for lunch at 1 p.m. In afternoon we visited the vast plain area north of Deniliquin. Very nice picnic dinner with mandatory wine and then we went for the *Plains-wanderer*. The night trip also included *Stubble Quail*, *Little Buttonquail*, *Barn Owl*, *Australian Owlet-Nightjar* and *Tawny Frogmouth*. 103 species today.

9 Oct

Breakfast at 7 a.m. In morning we birded **East of Deniliquin** and managed to pick up some “late” target species, e.g. *Black Honeyeater*. Lunch in Deniliquin. In afternoon transport to **Beechworth** with a longer stop in **Warby Range State Forest**. Not so good bird activity but we had good views of *Speckled Warbler*. High standard on the Motel, less so in the restaurant. 105 species today (highest number in the trip).

10 Oct

Breakfast at 6.30 a.m. We spend the whole day in **Chiltern area** and **Mt Pilot NP**. Quite a few interesting birds like *Painted Buttonquail* (very good views), *White-backed Swallow* (the only one for the trip), *Leaden* and *Restless Flycatcher* and *White-throated Gerygone*. At night we were upgraded to an Italian restaurant, less noisy than yesterday. Good wine and delicious dishes! 98 species today.

11 Oct

Breakfast at 6 a.m. and birding in Beechworth area until 10.30 a.m. We managed to find our first *Gang-gang Cockatoo* and after a long search we got good views of a *Barking Owl*. Quite tricky bird to catch. Transport to Alexandra and a new delicious Patricia picnic lunch. Just after Alexandra we were happy to find a *Short-beaked Echidna*. We continued to **Healesville** and stopped at **Yarra Range NP** 3.10–6.30 p.m. Many people/families around but we managed to get very decent views of a *Superb Lyrebird*. Other goodies were *Australian King-Parrot*, *Rose Robin* and *Lewin’s Honeyeater*. Nice dinner place in Healesville before we continued to Melbourne. 50 species today.

12 Oct

A new highly interesting leg of the trip – **Tasmania**. After breakfast at 6.30 a.m. we had a swift flight to **Hobart** (8.15–9.30). We met Tonia Cochran, our guide and host during the Tasmania visit. We saw some *Swift Parrot* at the airport before we went to the **Bruny Island** ferry. At the mainland harbor we saw our first Tasmania endemics – *Black-faced Cormorant*. After lunch we birded at South Bruny Island until dinner time at 6.15 p.m and found the *Forty-spotted Pardalote* among many other good birds. After dinner we visited the *Little Penguin* rookery at **Adventure Bay**. We also saw *Short-tailed Shearwater* here (100+). Later on in the night we drove

slowly back watching mammals. Göran was surprisingly good to ‘torch’ the mammals we found, although he was sleeping almost the whole night. 54 species today.

13 Oct

Breakfast at 6.30 a.m. and left our cottage at 7.15. It was a rainy morning (until 9 o’ clock). A short birding stop at **Cloudy Bay** before we took off with a small aircraft heading for **Melaleuca** in **Southwest NP**. Melaleuca was one of the most interesting places we visited in Australia, a very remote area. We found the expected bird easily, e.g. *Orange-bellied Parrot*, and, as bonus, some of us heard a calling *Ground Parrot*. We stayed at Melaleuca 10–15.45. The flight back was in better light than in the morning. The forest under us looked very interesting but tough to reach. In afternoon we stopped at different places in **Adventure Bay** before another delicious dinner. All the Tasmanian endemics were now secured. Tonia had very good knowledge about the rare endemics territory and the trip had evolved to an excellent dining trip! 65 species today.

14 Oct

Early departure (before breakfast) at 6 o’ clock. We went straight to **S Bruny Island NP**. The best bird here was 2 calling *Ground Parrot*, the first record since the huge fire seven years ago. Also good views of *Tawny-crowned Honeyeater*. It was also a scenic place with the light house beautiful situated to the skyline. After breakfast we had a slow and long transport to **Mt field NP**. Lunch stop in Hobart and some smaller birding stop at **Hamlet Downs**. At late afternoon we found a swimming *Platypus* close to our accommodation – a really nice experience. Night drive for mammals with many *Tasmanian Pademelons*. 52 species today.

15 Oct

Early breakfast at 5.15 a.m. and drive to Hobart Airport. Flight Hobart – Sydney 8.50 – 10.30. Left Sydney at 1.15 p.m. for Noumea New Caledonia, see trip report for New Caledonia.

21 Oct

Arrived in **Sydney** at lunch time. Picked up our mini bus and tried to locate our Hotel. We found out that there were two Hotels in Sydney with the same name, we chose the wrong one. Anyhow, once again the Australians show us a nice manner, incl. the parking ticket lady, and directed us to the correct address. No particularly activities during the afternoon. Free time. Dinner close to our hotel at some kind of “famous people” spot. Very nice people working there

22 Oct

Full day pelagic birding with Hal Epstein on Halicat Tours. Steve Anyon-Smith was the bird guide on board. We were very impressed by Steve, not only his birding skills but also because that he never used any bins during the whole day. (It was a relief to see him put on his reading glasses when studying the bird book.) The Tasman Sea was quite rough this day and some people got sea sickness. We were out between 07.30 and 16.15 and went quite far out. Many seabirds during the trip, 5 species of *Albatrosses*, incl. one immature *Grey-headed Albatross*. Also 2 *Humpback Whale*, 5 *Sunfish* and 1 *Blue Shark*. Dinner at an Indian restaurant. This was our last supper together.

23 Oct

Full day birding together with Steve Anyon-Smith in **Royal NP**, south of Sydney. We left our hotel at 5.40 a.m. and reached the park at 6.20. Among many nice species we found *Wonga Pigeon*, *Scaly-breasted Lorikeet*, *Powerful Owl*, *Rufous Fantail*, *Black-faced Monarch*, *Chestnut-rumped Heathwren*, *Large-billed* and *Yellow-throated Scrubwren*, *Brown Gerygone*, *Scarlet Honeyeater* and *Green Catbird*, they were all new for the trip. We left Bengt, Christer and Sören J at the hotel. They had a flight back to Europe at lunch time the next day. The other members of the team continued to **Litghow in Blue Mountains**.

24 Oct

We met our last guide, Tony Palliser, early morning at our hotel and went directly to **Glen Davis** area in Blue Mountains. Tony had good knowledge about Blue Mountains and tried hard to fulfill our last expectations. It wasn’t easy for Tony to find something new for us at this late stage of the trip, but he did well! A pair of *Rock Warbler* showed themselves extremely well, good-looking *Plum-headed Finch* and several *Bell Miner* was a nice ending of our birding in Australia. We went back to Sydney and left Roger and Sören S at the airport. They had a night flight back to Europe. Last dinner at the “famous people”.




