

Namibia and Botswana July 29 - August 12 2009

Introduction

Africa is addictive! Three years ago we visited Tanzania and the year after South Africa. In autumn 2008 we decided we wanted to go there again. Namibia sounded like a perfect destination. We contacted Birding Africa (<http://www.birdingafrica.com>) and asked them to propose a suitable itinerary which should include as many interesting birding destinations as possible. We soon agreed on taking the classic bird watching route:

Windhoek – Walvis Bay – Spitzkoppe/Erongo – Etosha – Okavango Panhandle (Botswana) – Waterberg Plateau Park – Windhoek.

Traveling with our children we were limited to travel when school has vacation – in Swedish summer time. This, of course, means winter time in the southern hemisphere and also that some migrants would not be present (like Cuckoos etc.). On the other hand winter time is the best when it comes to watching game in Etosha. Because the vast area is very dry the animals gather at the waterholes and are therefore much easier to see.
