Birding trip to Foping NNR, Southern Shaanxi **CHINA**

16-20 May & 10 & 11 June 2012

In mid-May 2012 I made a birding trip from Beijing down to southern Shaanxi & Sichuan provinces. During this trip I was fortunate to be able to visit Foping National Nature Reserve (NNR) twice – spending parts of five days there in mid-May and parts of another two days there in early June. I went alone in May but was accompanied by Mrs Qingyu WANG, a Beijing based travel agent who is the ground agent for several of the Chinese bird tours that I lead for Sunbird and Wings, in June. As always Qingyu did a fabulous job & I would not hesitate to recommend her. Her address is -

Brief Itinerary

16 May: Flew Beijing to Xi'an, Shaanxi Province. Transferred from there to Foping.

17 May: All day in Foping National Nature Reserve (NNR). Drove to Liangfengya (Liang Feng Ya) & spent much of the day

around there.

18 May: All day in Foping NNR. Drove to Liangfengya & spent much of the day around there.

19 May: All day in Foping NNR. Drove to Liangfengya & spent much of the day around there.

20 May: Morning Foping NNR. Drove to Liangfengya & spent a few hours there before driving back to Xi'an. Late afternoon

flight to Chengdu.

9June: Pm flight from Chengdu to Xi'an. Late pm arrived Foping town.

10 June: All day Foping NR. Drove to Liangfengya & spent much of the day around there.

11 June: Morning Foping, afternoon drove south to Sichuan.

I'd previously visited Foping just once before for five days between 24-28 May 2004 but, with the discovery of Blackthroat by Per Alström & others there in June 2011, I was eager to return. This report describes what I did & saw on my recent visits.

Acknowledgements

First and foremost to WANG Qingyu for arranging my visit and making everything run so smooth. Mr HE at Foping liaised with Qingyu and was even kind enough to come and meet me on my arrival at Xi'an airport. He spoke good English and was very friendly and helpful. My driver Mr LIANG was similarly friendly and always punctual – even though driving really isn't his job. GONG Huisheng deserves a special mention as he accompanied me on all three of my days in the field – he was good fun, knowledgeable and great company.

Per Alström provided me with some details on where he found Blackthroat in May 2011 – and had uploaded a recording of its song on the internet. Richard Lewthwaite provided me with a very useful and informative Shaanxi checklist.

Wednesday 16 May 2004. Beijing to Xi'an & on to Foping town

I left Tongzhou at 04h45, drove to terminal 3 of Beijing's Capital Airport where my Air China (CA1203) flight to Xi'an was scheduled to depart at 07h25. The plane pulled away from the gate right on time and, unusually for busy Beijing airport, took off just eight minutes later. The flight south to Xi'an took 1.5 hours and we landed at 09h09.

I was met as I exited luggage reclaim at Xi'an airport by two of Foping NNR's staff - Mr HE and driver/photographer Mr LIANG & very shortly afterwards (at 09h40) the three of us were heading south on route S108 to the Qinling Shan (Qinling Mountains) and Foping.

We had lunch in a Muslim noodle restaurant in Mazhao & left there at 12h05

Banfanzi 13h35 1105 metres

Long road tunnel 14h00 1690 metres Foping NNR stars immediately on the south side of this tunnel.

Junction up to Liangfengya 14h10

Arrived Foping town 14h45 890 metres

There was no electricity in the entire town today – though it came on at about 19h30.

We drove straight to the reserve's guest house – the Fobao Zhu hotel where I checked in & dropped my bags in the room. Mr HE then introduced me to Mr GONG Huisheng who was keen to show me a few of the specimens he had prepared – these included two Giant Pandas, a magnificent Red Flying Squirrel, a gorgeous Mountain Hawk Eagle that had been confiscated from a local farmer in November 2011 but died shortly afterwards, as well as a pair of Temminck's Tragopans, a male Koklass and a male Golden Pheasant. Mr GONG would be my guide during my time at Foping – all foreigners must have guides here. He charged 300 yuan/day – but if he worked longer than eight hours (which he certainly would) this went up to 400/day.

Weather

According to the cabin crew it was 20°C when the plane landed in Xi'an at 09h10. This had climbed to 30°C by 13h30 as we started to climb in to the mountains (990 metres).

Thursday 17 May 2012. Most of the day in Foping NNR.

I left the Fobao Zhu hotel with driver Mr LIANG & reserve guide Mr GONG Huisheng seven minutes late at 04h07. We drove about 25 kilometres back up route S108 towards Xi'an before turning off left (west) just under 40 minutes later on to a minor road. Liangfengya Baohuzhan (= Liangfengya Monitoring Station & apparently previously known as the Cun Gou Monitoring Post 33°41.4′ N., 107°53.5′ E. & 1720 metres) is another eight kilometres up this cul-de-sac. There's a check post and road barrier at Liangfengya but apparently very few staff. The barrier always had a chain around it – but was never locked and there were no staff in evidence in the early mornings – though there invariably were when we returned in the afternoons.

From Liangfengya it took us less than 15 minutes to drive the remaining five kilometres up to the end of the road. Arriving there at 05h00 we spent the rest of the morning and early afternoon in that area. There were a lot of workmen at the end of the road in mid-May 2012 and they'd already finished building a large Foping NNR/UNESCO archway and were in the process of constructing a small building – possibly a ticket office.

From the end of the road at Liangfengya (33°41.1' N., 107°51.3' E.)(2130 metres) its 22.5 kilometres at 151° as the crow flies back to Foping town.

There are three paths right on this col – I intend to explore the one off to the left (south) tomorrow, the middle path heads obviously downhill and goes to the Sanguanmiao Protection Station where WANG Qingyu & me stayed in May 2004. Today we spent much of the day (from 05h30 when it was just about light enough to see until 14h00) on the third trail - a small & initially well paved trail that leads off to the right immediately above the small toilet block. According to Mr GONG this trail was paved in about 2004 - is fairly flat for the first 100 metres or so and then heads uphill more steeply. After about 800 metres you reach an elaborate, multi-storey steel watch tower (33°41.4' N., 107°51.1' E. 2283 metres). The trail continues on up from there – but is unpaved and at times rather indistinct. The trail more-or-less follows a north-south oriented bamboo covered ridge. Its occasionally fairly steep and there were the odd grassy clearings and rocky outcrops. The latter in particular afforded good views of the surrounding area – and the extent and quality of the forest at Foping was massively impressive! I understood from GONG Huisheng that it would be possible to continue right up this trail, on to the distant hill top and come down another ridge. I suspect that this trail isn't for slow moving birders carrying lots of recording equipment however!

Today I walked up to 2440 metres where I arrived at 11h15. This was 1.4 kilometres as the crow flies back to where we'd left the car at the end of the road – but it had been about a 2.5 kilometre walk. I understood from Per's notes & from what Mr GONG told me that this site is where they found Blackthroat in June 2011 – but there was absolutely not sign of even a single bird here today! Interestingly almost all of my sightings today were below all of Per's the previous summer!

After a short while here we headed slowly back down, arrived back at the vehicle at 14h00. We headed back to Foping town shortly after that. We arrived back at the main Xi'an to Foping road (route S108) 30 minutes later at 14h30 & back in Foping town after another half-an-hour. The three of us had lunch in a restaurant in town before I was dropped off back at the Fobao Zhu hotel.

On my 2004 visit we took a taxi up to the end of the road at Liangfengya & then immediately started to walk to Sanguanmiao. Our guide that year, Mr DANG, told us that the trail to Sanguanmiao was about 15 kilometres long – I later guessed that it was less than this, perhaps 12, but in any case it was a good walk and we couldn't hang about too much. It was a good trail, almost exclusively downhill & there were no major side paths – so it would be very difficult to get lost. In the event I let Mr DANG & Qingyu take the lead & I walked alone – arriving at our destination more than two hours after Mr Dang! It was a glorious morning – until about 10h15 when it started to rain. By 11h00 it was raining very hard & continued to do so for the remainder of the day. Nevertheless the birding was excellent – especially for the first few hours on the trail and I guess that I hadn't walked more than three kilometres in the first three hours! That year we started our walk at 06h30.

In 2004 I arrived at Sanguanmiao (33° 39.0'N., 107° 48.0'E.& 1528 metres) thoroughly soaked at about 14h00. Foping is 22.7 kilometres & 134° from Sanguanmiao, the road end above Liangfengya is 8.43 kilometres & 76°). Note that in 2004 the accommodation at Sanguanmiao was rather simple – there are about a dozen rooms, several were occupied by the six park staff that were based there. The one we stayed in had two beds - a double & a single. There are no facilities in the rooms & a basic, hole in the floor toilet to the rear of the accommodation block. Our food was included in the price Mr DANG had passed on to Qingyu – we paid 2800 yuan for five days, four nights inside the park. This price included all our accommodation (the hotel in Foping town had gone up 20 yuan by 2012 as it only cost 100 yuan/room/night in 2004, the guest house at Sanguanmiao 80

yuan/room/night), three meals a day inside the park, a 500 yuan/day park protection fee (note that even Chinese visitors must pay this), the services of one porter to carry our luggage & Mr DANG's guiding fees. The food at Sanguanmiao was OK – only that.

Foping National Nature Reserve.

Situated north west of Foping town, which is itself 158 kilometres north-east of Hanzhong & 208 kilometres south of Xi'an, & lying to the west of National Highway 208 which connects these two cities, the park was established in 1978 & now covers an area of 292.4 km². Contiguous with three other reserves in the Qinling Shan of southern Shaanxi – Lao Xian Cheng NR & Zhou Zhi NNR to the north and Chang Qing NNR to the west Foping NNR is probably the most frequently visited of these parks. Almost completed forested (apart from relatively small areas of cultivation around the settlement of Sanguanmiao) the park covers an altitudinal range of 1924 metres with the highest peak, Lu Ban Feng (2904 metres), forming the central point of the reserve's northern border. The park's lowest point, Daguping (Da Gu Ping) Pao Tong Gou (980 metres), is besides the Xi River in the park's south-eastern district.

Primarily a Giant Panda reserve Foping's reputedly the best place in the world to see this species in the wild, April apparently being the best month. Qingyu & me failed to see it in 2004 – but I was superbly successful in 2012. The park also boasts reasonable populations of Golden Snub-nosed Monkey *Rhinopithecus roxellana* (one of the staff at Sanguanmiao told us that October may be the best time to see these although Mr DANG believed that there was no particularly good time to see this notoriously elusive species). Takin is also locally common in the reserve – I saw lots of signs (fresh hoof prints & dung) in 2012 – but no actual animal!

In June 2011 Per Alström and others discovered a population of Blackthroat near the road end above Liangfengya and it was this species that I had primarily come to see. It proved to be extremely easy in mid-May but significantly harder in early June. Note also that I only saw it in one, tiny area.

Foping park is apparently divided in to two or three zones – a more remote north-western 'core zone' & an 'experimental zone' that appears to contain a 'tourist zone' with accommodation at Sanguanmiao & Daguping.

There's a rather incomplete and now dated but still useful bird list, containing 217 species, in one of the park's publications. [Liu Shifeng & Zhang Jian. Foping National Nature Reserve – Protect the Animals & Plants. Part XI pp. 427-472: Birds of Foping Sanctuary. (2003). Shaanxi Scientific Publishing Company. (In Chinese). (ISBN 7-5369-3446-7)]. A table in the paper presents brief coded details of the date of first occurrence of each species in the park as well as coded comments on their seasonal status & their altitudinal preference. However in only 4½, somewhat rainy, days inside the reserve in 2004 I noted 83 species that included 18 species that weren't on this list! The new birds that I saw for Foping NNR in 2004 were –

A more recent version of the park checklist can be found on the park's Chinese language website – <u>www.fpnr.org</u>. Mr HE kindly gave me a small document listing about 15 more recent additions to this on-line list.

Unlike several of China's National Parks rather few people, other than park staff, actually live inside Foping NNR. There's a small cluster of perhaps 6-10 dwellings & attendant small areas of cultivation (maize & potatoes were conspicuous crops in late May 2004) in the Sanguanmiao (San Guan Miao)/Hejiazhuang (He Jia Zhuang) area. In 2004 I was told that there were 79 park staff & all of these are salaried, receiving their wages (because it's a National Park) from the Department of Forestry in Beijing. Although designated as a National Park as early as 1978 it apparently wasn't until 1993 that a decree was issued preventing people from

felling trees & in the 10 years 1985-1995 only 4 people were caught, tried & found guilty of this crime while a further 10 were convicted of killing wild animals inside the park during the same period. Sanguanmiao Protection Station was built in 1982 & is, like all the other protection stations, manned all year round.

The wet season in the park corresponds with a northern winter (October-March) & Sanguanmiao apparently receives moderate amounts of snow fall each winter. The earliest recorded autumnal snow fall at Sanguanmiao is 21 September but in one year the first snow of the winter didn't fall until the 25 October.

I didn't get anywhere near Sanguanmiao on my 2012 visit – concentrating instead on a very small area near the end of the road just above Liangfengya.

We spent the rest of the day on the unpaved dirt track that heads to the south of the road end. This trial is initially gently uphill and reaches another elaborate, multi-storey steel watch tower after about one kilometre. From here it starts to descend & eventually (according to Mr GONG after 36 kilometres!) leads to Yueba. We walked perhaps three kilometres on this trail, descending to 2010 metres, before turning back. It was then 11h45. Arriving back at the vehicle at 13h15 we loaded up & headed back to Foping town where we arrived at 14h10.

After a while here we headed on up to the end of the road where we arrived at 05h50. I spent a couple of hours walking about one kilometre back down the road before returning to the road end and heading back up the 'Blackthroat trail'. I spent the rest of the morning and the early afternoon on this trail (09h00-14h10) and climbed as high as about 2400 metres.

We headed back to Foping town at 14h20.
